

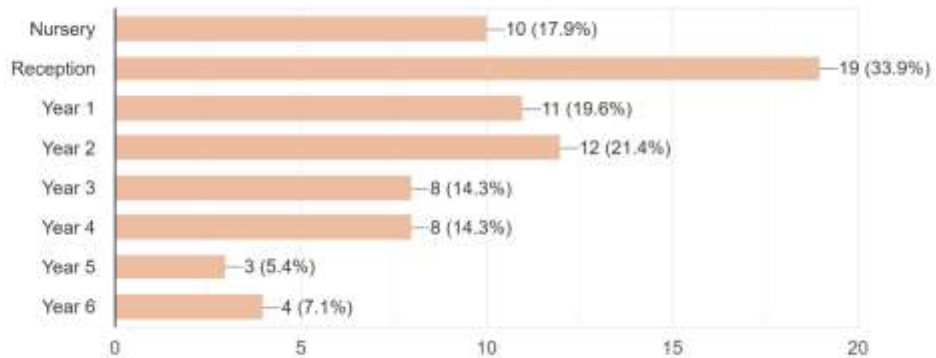

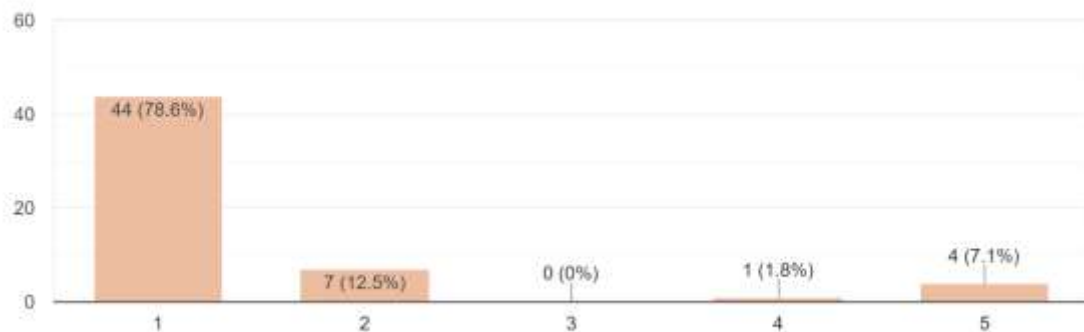

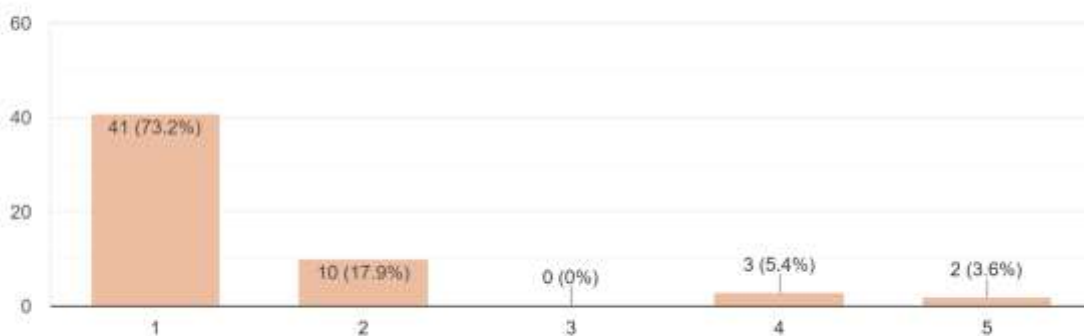
My child feels safe at Hareside Primary.

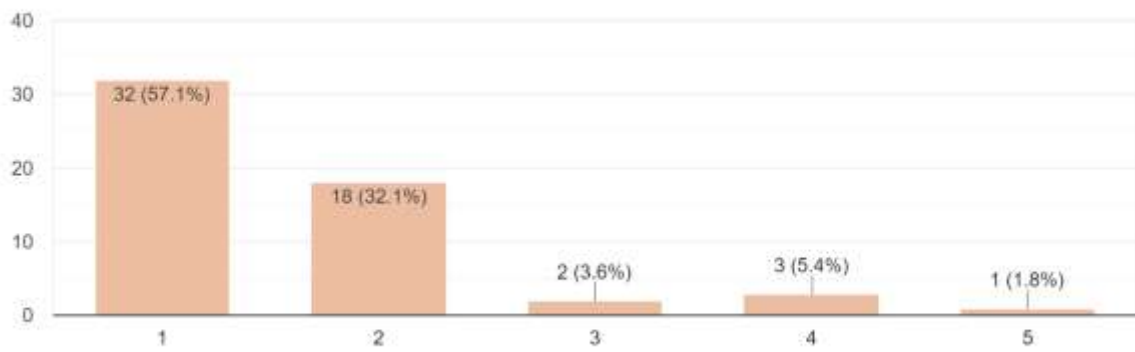
My child is happy at Hareside Primary.

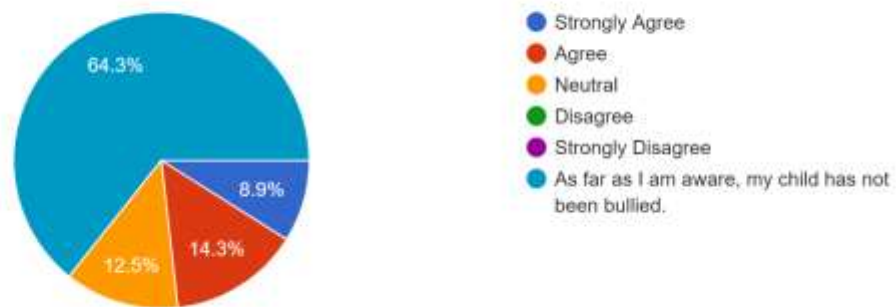
Hareside Primary makes sure it's pupils are well behaved.

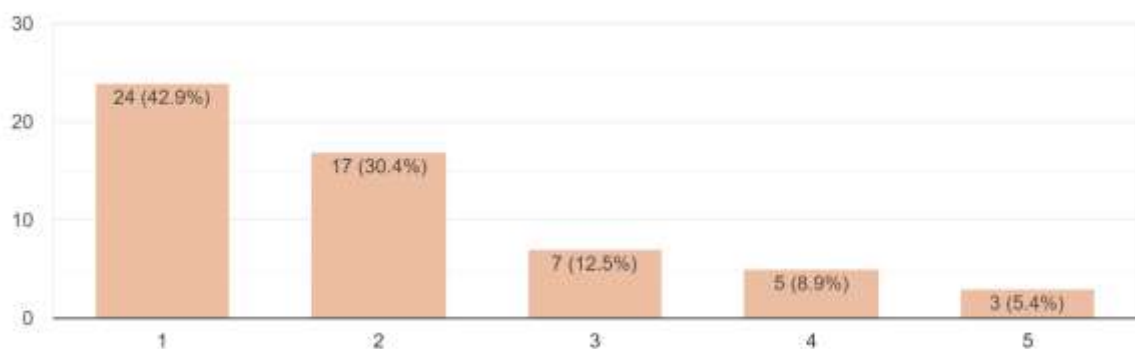
My child has been bullied at school and Hareside Primary dealt with it quickly and effectively.

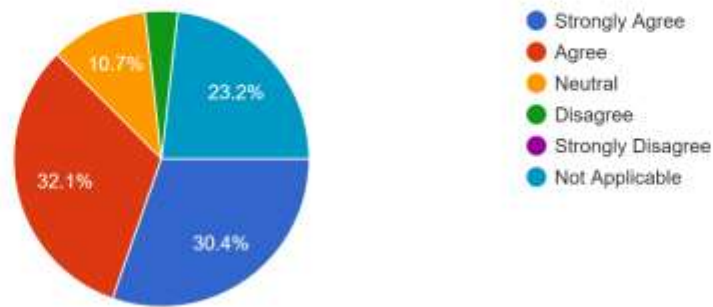
The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.

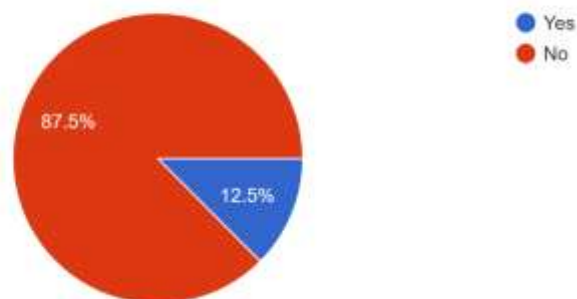
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.

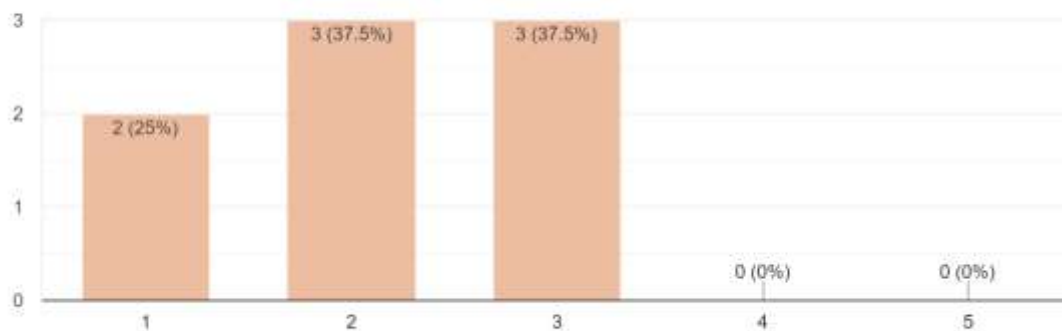
Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)?

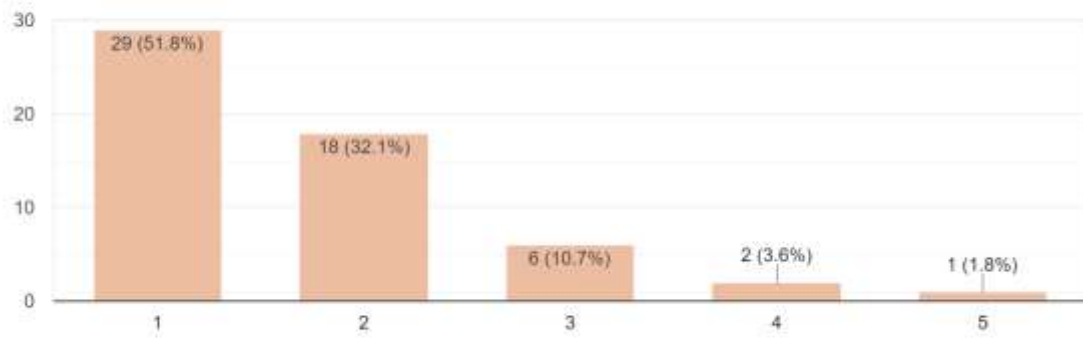
If you answered "Yes" to the last question, how strongly do you agree with the following statement...

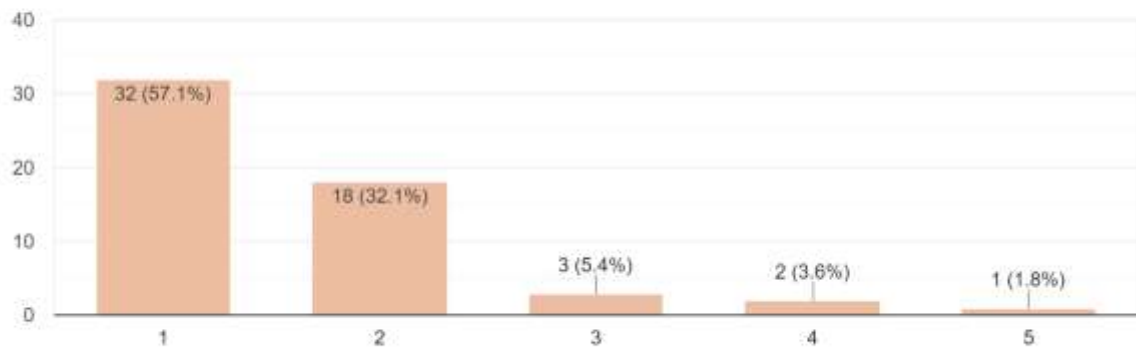
The school has high expectations for my child.

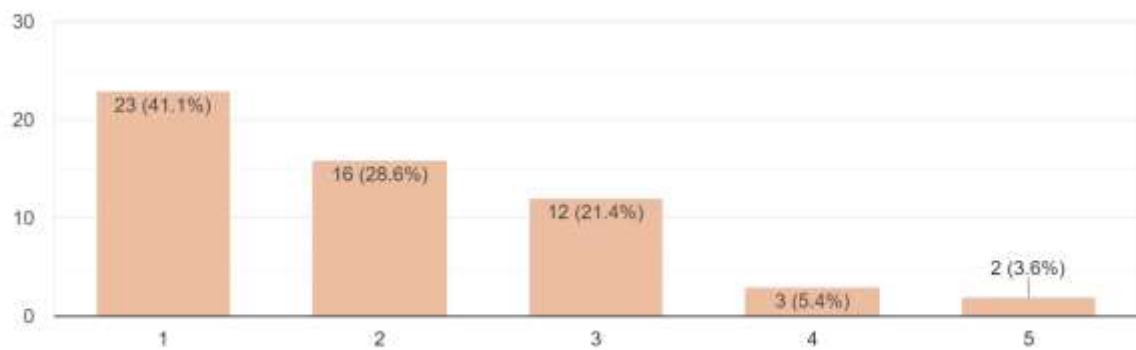
My child does well at Hareside Primary.

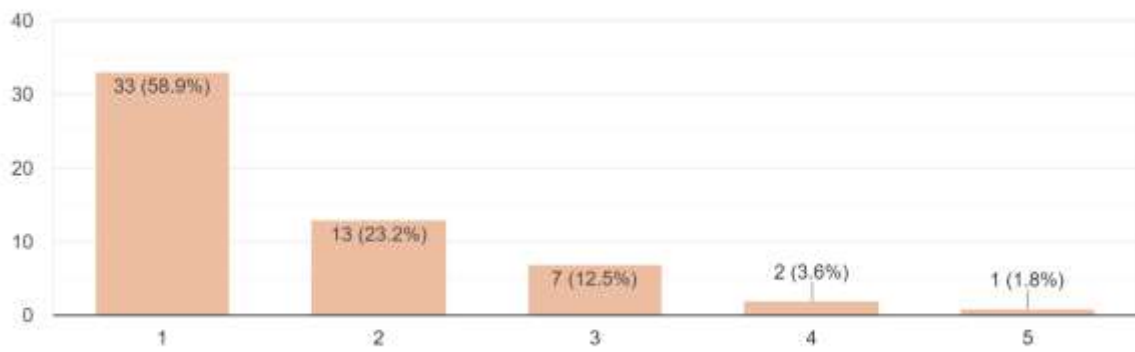
The school lets me know how my child is doing.

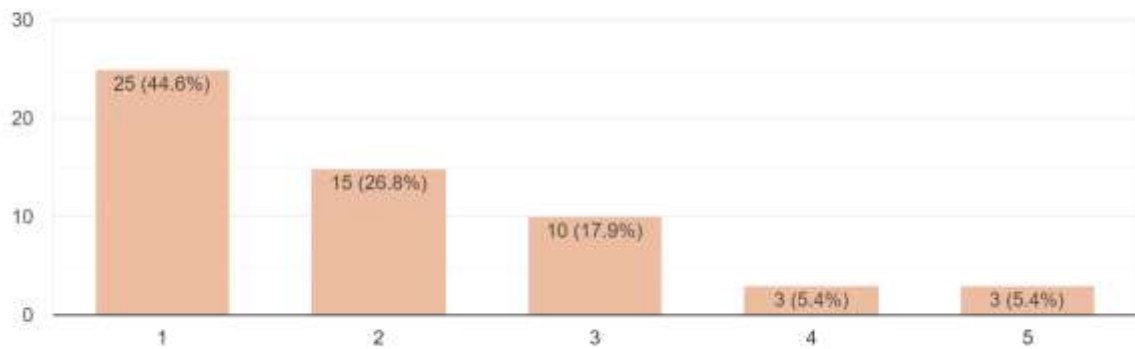
There is a good range of subjects available to my child at Hareside Primary.

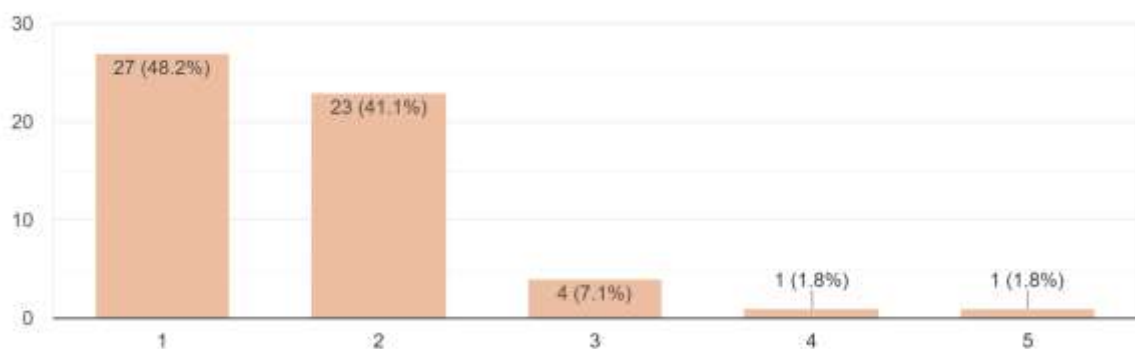
My child can take part in clubs and activities at Hareside Primary.

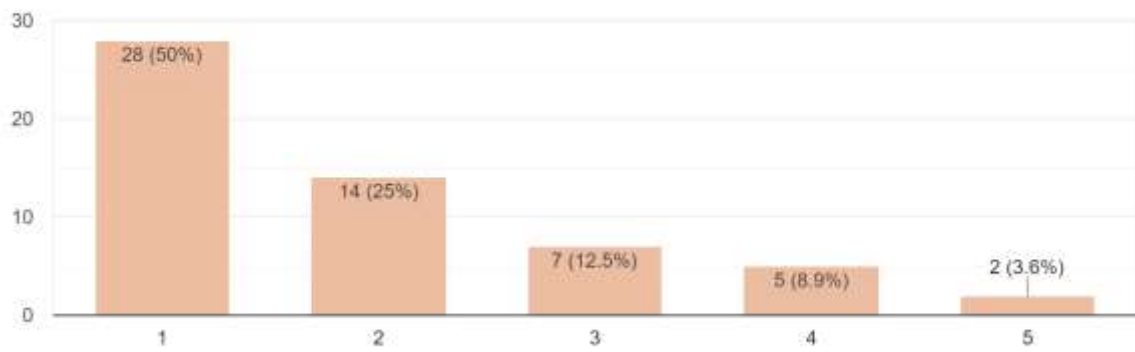
Hareside Primary supports my child's wider development.

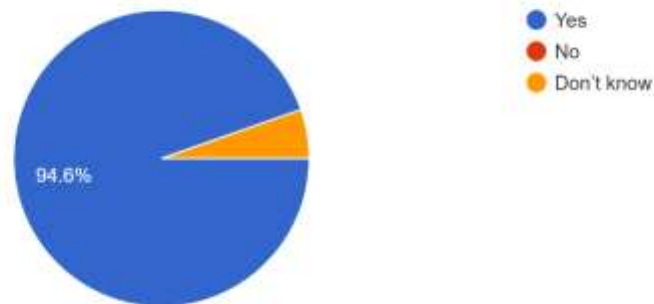
Hareside Primary is well led and managed.

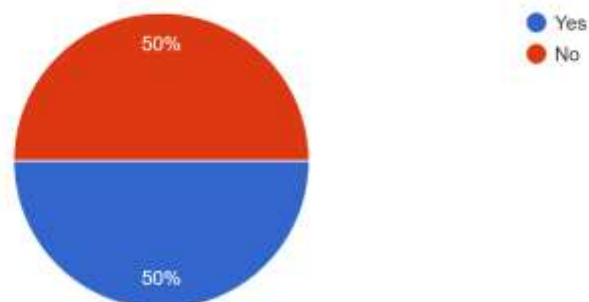

COMMENTS, SUGGESTIONS AND POSITIVE PRAISE

We are delighted with the depth and quantity of information provided in support of your views. Here are just a few of the comments...

Suggestions for improvement in green and positive praise in blue.

"... when you get asked to do homework on a Friday for the Monday; I work the full weekend and am a single parent so I don't have much time with my child to be able to complete these things but during the week I would be able to and feel more time is better for the both of us so we can both help and understand the task at hands without feeling rushed or worried"

"My daughter absolutely loves being part of this school, which makes me more than happy with everything the school is doing."

"If possible a wider range of after school clubs. Treat days for the children and a wider range of school trips offered. More use of forestry school and yurt." "it would be nice for more fun events to take place at school" Earlier communication about upcoming events, also more things socially for the children."

"Only new to Hareside in September, myself and my husband are more than happy with what has already been offered to our boys. ... they were not used to such a wide variety of activities and equipment, this has been such a positive change for both boys."

"We miss the coffee afternoons"

"Happy with my children's teachers and the schools leadership team. Great communication from the school through emails. Thank you all."

"... maybe the stone path between reception and the upper years could be changed to accommodate pushchairs..."

"My children enjoy Hareside after recently only joining, they have made many friends and been made to feel very welcome, everyone seems friendly."

"I would like to hear more about what the children are learning and see their actual work rather than at show and tell. Pick up and drop off is very impersonal and busy and it's difficult to speak to the teacher or they speak to us."

"I'm so grateful for all the support I have had and I can never thank you all enough"

"I also find the Seesaw apps very difficult to navigate. Pre Covid homework in a text book worked much better than it all now being online."

"I feel like the school goes above and beyond to help all children reach their full potential."

"I would like to see some sports based after school activities." "More after school classes"

"Learning is shared very well after the topics have been taught through tapestry or show and tell evenings."

"An induction / meeting for parents of adopted or previously LAC or children with SEN prior to starting at the school to establish needs would be beneficial."

"I really like the What's happening at Hareside emails!"

"I would find it beneficial if more clubs could be open to younger children."

"I like that the school tries to help parents for example world book day not expecting children to dress up and having to buy extra things that will be worn once. It not only helps parents financially, but saves time and is environmentally considerate. I like that the schools focus is on education but it can still be fun with what we have already."

"it would be helpful for parents to know what topics they are going to learn so that they can provide further learning opportunities at home"

"I'd like to start by saying that our child loves attending Hareside and that she is making, from what we can gather, excellent progress."

"Having a newsletter maybe once a month or half term about the individual year groups could be nice, so smaller achievements could be mentioned (eg a swimming badge gained or similar) and to highlight what has been happening. Mentioning house points and star of the week could be nice too." "Would there be anything to do for fundraising?"

"As a parent of a child who now gets 1-1 support the whole Process of getting him an ECHP has been brilliant, and being part of the process made me understand more and I've been able to work with the school..."

"early notice of new term dates and holiday clubs would be helpful."
